



### 3 Things to Remember When Interacting with Someone Using a Mobility Aid

1. **Respect personal space and belongings:** Ask before touching or moving wheelchairs, crutches, canes, and walkers.
2. **Ask permission** before you start pushing someone's wheelchair or physically touching/supporting someone in any way. Listen, and respect individual preferences.
3. **Try to be eye to eye:** If the person is in a wheelchair, try to sit down so that you can look one another in the eye.
